Tasties teasers Host an Afternoon Tea dance


Music is such a great way to get people moving, even if it is just a foot! It also evokes memories.

Arrange the chairs in a big circle, it will make it easier for everyone to see each other. and make sure there is enough space if people want to get up and dance.




